

LOW-INCOME DISCOUNT PROGRAM (LIDP) GUIDELINES

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Northshore Utility District ("District") is accepting applications for the 2023-2024 Low-Income Discount Program (July 1, 2023 - June 30, 2024). The program is available to all qualified single-and multi-family residential households.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

To be eligible for the program, applicants must provide the following proof:

1. Income qualifications: The combined income of all adult household members of all properties must not exceed fifty percent (50%) of the current King County Department of Housing and Urban Development ("HUD") area median household income calculation as set for the number of occupants in the household. For 2022 these amounts are as follows:

1 person	2 persons	3 persons	4 persons	5 persons	6 persons	7 persons	8 persons

- 2. Full-time residency at the address receiving utility service for any portion of the current application year.
- **3. Proof of utility bill payment.** Directly-billed customers must prove they receive and submit payments to the District. Indirectly-billed customers must prove they pay District utility charges to a third-party apartment or mobile park complex office, landlord, or other agent.

PROGRAM DISCOUNT

LIDP customers will pay 45% of the current water base rate and 50% of the non-King County portion of the current sewer base rate.

Base rates are determined by the type of dwelling (see table on following page). The discount will **not** apply to water usage or any other charges the District assesses. LIDP customers **are** also eligible for the additional 5% early payment discount. Not sure which discounted rate you qualify for? Contact (425) 398-4402 or billing@nud.net.

HOW DISCOUNT WILL BE ISSUED:

The method through which program participants will receive the discounted rate depends on how they are billed by the District for water/sewer.

DIRECTLY-BILLED CUSTOMERS

Qualified customers who pay their water/sewer bills directly to the District – usually owners/renters of single-family residential properties, or multi-family properties with individual meters – will pay the discounted rate on their bi-monthly billing statement.

INDIRECTLY-BILLED CUSTOMERS

Qualified customers who pay for water/sewer through their rent, or as a separate charge to a property owner, agent, or third party – usually tenants of apartments, condominiums, or mobile home residences – will pay the usual rates. At the end of the program year, they will receive a rebate check for the difference between the usual base rate paid and the discounted rate for each qualified month they lived at the residence during the program year. See table below with example.

NOTE: Many multi-family property owners hire a third party to bill tenants and subsequently charge tenants the cost of this service. The District can only rebate for water/sewer base rates. We cannot reimburse additional charges assessed to the tenant by the owner for these third-party billing services.

EXAMPLE REBATE: This table shows 2023 LIDP rates for an apartment unit (5 or more total complex units) paying water and sewer for a full year (6 billing cycles):

HOW TO APPLY:

- 1. Fill out the appropriate form depending on your property type single-family or individually-metered residence or multi-family residence with shared meter.
